



- ❑ **CREATE AN ACCOUNT** on the SWE member portal - AA.
- ❑ **SEND A PICTURE** of your affiliate members to international@swe.org so we can introduce your new affiliate in our next global newsletter.
- ❑ **FOLLOW SWE** on **Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn** and **YouTube** to stay up-to-date on the latest happenings. In addition to SWE's HQ social media handles, follow our international handles:

One Month

Within 1 month of launching your affiliate, you should...

- ❑ **LEARN MORE ABOUT SWE'S MISSION, GOALS AND PROGRAMS** in the **About SWE** course. To view the course, log in at swe.org and use **SWEINTL20** as the coupon code at check-out.
- ❑ **CREATE SOCIAL MEDIA PAGES** for your affiliate to start spreading the word about your new group and encouraging others to get involved. Encourage members to take photos and videos of your activities to share with the community. Consider using a social media management tool like **Hootsuite** or **Buffer** to help drive engagement and review the **SWE Social Media Policy** for more guidance.
- ❑ **READ MORE ABOUT SWE'S ACTIVITIES** in the **All Together** blog and award-winning **SWE Magazine**.
- ❑ **REACH OUT TO THE GLOBAL AMBASSADOR(S)** in your country or region. Ambassadors are a great resource, especially in the beginning if you have questions about getting your affiliate started.

Three Months

Within 3 months of launching your affiliate, you should...

- ❑ **CREATE A WEBSITE** for your affiliate to promote your group, share information about upcoming events, and post your contact information. **Submit a Weebly request** to easily build a website at no cost to you.
- ❑ **DECIDE ON A MEETING SCHEDULE AND FORMAT** that works best for your group. This could be once a month, once a quarter, in-person, conference call, etc. Scheduling regular meetings with your group will help you stay organized and in-touch with members.
- ❑ **JOIN THE NEXT SWE QUARTERLY AFFILIATE CALL.** Each quarter, affiliate leaders join a call where they hear updates from SWE staff, discuss important issues and share feedback & suggestions with others.
- ❑ **LEARN ABOUT THE AFFILIATE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM**, which can help offset expenses related to affiliate operations, events, and travel.
- ❑ **REVIEW THE SWE BRAND GUIDELINES** and ensure that your affiliate is properly representing the Society's trademark.
- ❑ **GET TO KNOW OTHER GLOBAL AFFILIATES.** With more than 50 global affiliates, there may be others in your country or region that you can connect with.



Six Months

Within 6 months of launching your affiliate, you should...

- ❑ **ELECT AFFILIATE LEADERS.** Once your affiliate has grown to an appropriate size, consider implementing a leadership structure to organize and distribute work. Roles you may want to include are President, Vice President, Secretary, Membership Director, Communications Director or Outreach Director. Once in place, elections can be held at the end of each fiscal year.
- ❑ **DEFINE YOUR AFFILIATE'S GOALS.** Are you focused on professional development? Dedicated to STEM outreach to girls? Passionate about advocating for women engineers? Clearly defining your goals is an important first step in creating a strong foundation for your affiliate.
- ❑ **EXPLORE THE SWE MARKETING FLYERS.** Consider distributing these in your community or adapting them to fit your specific needs. You can also contact SWE to receive a complimentary sampling of printed marketing flyers.
- ❑ **ENCOURAGE ALL AFFILIATE MEMBERS TO PURCHASE A SWE MEMBERSHIP** so they can receive full access to the many benefits of our community. Learn about special **discounts that might be available in your country.**
